

Instructions for Tournaments Host

1. Acquire gyms at the time of sanctioning and follow up on court availability well in advance of the tournament. **All facilities must meet ADA requirements.**
2. The region is committed to complying with federal and state disability law. All LSR-sanctioned teams and all LSR-sanctioned tournaments must comply with applicable federal and state disability laws, including the Americans with Disabilities Act and Texas Human Resource Code § 121.001 et seq. Tournament hosts and teams participating in LSR-sanctioned tournaments all must provide qualified sign language interpreters to the extent required by law to ensure that individuals who are deaf and hard of hearing have full and equal access to communications at tournaments. Entities participating in the region must provide qualified sign language interpreters as the law requires to ensure full and equal access to communications at all tryouts and team activities, such as practices, clinics, and games.
3. Recruit knowledgeable court managers and review assignment duties. Insurance liability requires court managers to be Lone Star Region members with cleared background and current SafeSport certification. If trainers are used, they must be USAV members, too.
4. Accept Region teams in order of entry by postmark or time of acceptance. (Lone Star Region teams will receive priority over non-region teams if in compliance with the entry deadline). All teams/individuals entered in your tournament must be USAV registered for the current season or USAV approved foreign teams. **DO NOT ACCEPT MORE TEAMS THAN CAN BE ACCOMMODATED BY THE NUMBER OF COURTS YOU HAVE AVAILABLE.**
5. Notify teams by mail, phone, AES or email of their acceptance and location of play. Teams need to receive notification as soon as possible after your entry deadline. **Note** – listing teams on your website does not satisfy the requirement of contacting teams for tournament acceptance.
6. Once teams have entered a tournament by the entry deadline, the tournament director should look at their numbers and decide if they have enough for each age division. If they do not have the numbers for a particular age division **AND** get permission from the Jr. Director to combine divisions, the tournament director must immediately notify the teams that will be affected. Teams should be allowed to drop, with a refund, if they do not wish to continue to participate in a combined age division. This will give teams time to find an additional tournament in their own age division. If there are two or more teams in an age group, the age groups should separate for playoffs. Matches played against teams in a different age group should not affect seedings for playoffs.
7. **Notify the Junior Director, Gloria Cox, if a tournament is canceled.** Please, copy Jack Zaldivar and Karen Tarmon on the cancellation email.
8. Spectator fees may be charged but the amount of the fees must be included in your tournament information or listed on your website. All tournament facilities, excluding convention centers, have a set maximum entry fee of \$15 per adult per day and \$7 for children 12 and under per day. The tournament host has the option to offer a discounted weekend pass but must provide spectators with the option to purchase a single (one) day pass. Note – the spectator fee will not apply to rostered members (including coaches/chaperones), LS board directors, Nat & Jr Nat referees.
9. Two weeks prior to the tournament event, submit pretournament team list complete with registered teams and team codes to jackscheduler@gmail.com for roster approval. Excel format should be used. A copy should also be sent to LSRregistrar@gmail.com
10. Utilize the LS Website <http://www.lsvolleyball.org/> for ranking information listed for each age group to seed the teams in the tournament. One week prior to tournament, submit seeded teams to Dick Kappel (kappel@att.net) for approval.
11. **Note:**
 - a) Teams may play in an age division higher with approval from the Junior Director
 - b) Teams may play in an age division higher if ranked in Division I of HPL with approval from the Junior Director.
 - c) Teams from a lower age group may be accepted after all the Lone Star Region teams of the appropriate age have been accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
 - d) Playing up an age division shall not improve the ranking of the lower age team. The appropriate age teams' rankings shall not be affected.

- e) Non-region teams are to be seeded by the tournament host.
 - f) Age groups may be combined with the permission of the Jr. Director.
12. Do not place teams in a higher division than the one in which they are registered except as noted above. For one day tournaments, 12 year-old boys' teams may play against 12 year-old girls' teams, 13 year-old boys' teams may play against 13 year-old girls' teams, and 14 year old boys' teams may play against 14 year old girls' teams; however, a boys' team cannot advance to the playoffs. **All teams must be informed that boys' teams will be included in the tournament.** The matches against the boys' teams do not count toward seeding for the playoffs.
 13. Place teams into pools using the 4 and/or 5 team pool schedules and make seeding adjustments to prevent teams from the same club being assigned to the same pool. The 6 and 7 team pool schedules are to be used only for abnormal situations. In deciding the first and second place teams, a playoff may be needed, if the teams have not actually played each other.
 - 4 team pool play matches shall be 2 of 3 sets and 5 team pool play shall be 2 sets.
 - Top two teams from each pool to advance to playoffs.
 - Playoffs are 2 of 3 sets
 - For one day tournaments, it is permissible to play one set to 25 points for quarter-finals.
 14. Photocopy, and provide as needed, the forms for court managers (pool sheets, lineup sheets, score sheets, etc.) Tournament information and forms are located on the LS website under Reference, Tournament Package.
 15. Supply game materials and equipment as necessary (game balls, towels, floor tape, etc.)
 16. Start on time and give awards the day of the event.
 17. By Monday, after your tournament, post the tournament results on the appropriate website (this info is automatic if you are using the AES tournament system.) It is permissible to show results on your website if it indicates the final standings of all team names, 11 digit code, age group/division. If you do not have a website, then email the Tournament Results Form to Dick Kappel.
 18. Developmental teams must have Impact Certified coaches and all participants must be USAV members. The teams are not required to have certified scorers or referees. The tournament list must be sent to the LS Registrar before the tournament, but the rankings and results do not need to be reported.
 19. **Within two weeks, print and complete the Tournament Financial Report (located in the Tournament Package under Reference on the Lone Star Region website.) Send the completed Tournament Financial Report and a check for the sanction fee of \$3.00 per team to Gloria Cox, Junior Director. Your tournament is not over until all reports have been completed and sent.**
